# **Funding**

#### **Ontario Agri-Careers Support Initiative**

A second round of this funding initiative is now open. This program is aimed at growing the labour market for food processing businesses by providing support for innovative pilot projects that address specific needs of employees at a community-based level so food processors can attract and retain workers. Ontario-based food processors that have over 50 employees are eligible. The deadline to apply is September 8, 2022. Specific details can be found in the <u>Program Guide</u>.

#### thriveFORWARD Initiative for start-ups and Small and Medium Sized Enterprises

This new program was launched to support industrial innovation investment that future proof businesses, create and maintain jobs, or adopt digital technology. Food production businesses can receive up to \$100,000 in funding. Applications are now being accepted until the program is fully subscribed.

#### **FoodShift**

The FoodShift program provides non-repayable funding for net-zero technology adoption to food and

beverage processors. Successful program participants can receive \$50,000 in matched funding.

## **Canadian Food & Wine Institute Innovation Centre**

<u>The Canadian Food & Wine Institute Innovation Centre</u>, located at Niagara College, has \$300,000 in annual funding to match 2-1 with industry for applied research projects to help organization bring new food and beverage products to market.

## The Food Innovation & Research Studio

The <u>Food Innovation & Research Studio</u> (FIRSt) George Brown College offers research and development support for food and beverage companies in their lab located in downtown Toronto. Companies can have access to food scientists, project managers, researchers and chefs to help develop new products. Services also include nutritional analysis, regulatory compliance and collecting consumer feedback.
