Member and Associate Fees

The ODC Board has approved a change to the Member and Associate fee schedule for the period April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024. Fees for the period will be adjusted using the 12-month rolling change in total CPI as of December 31, 2023 to a maximum of 3.4%. Once the actual percentage change is confirmed (approximately mid-January), ODC will advise Members and Associates. The non-bovine fee will increase to \$900 and the introductory new Member offer will not change.

Funding

<u>Canada Summer Jobs</u> - This fund provides a non-repayable grant for businesses to hire new employees 15-30 years of age. The employment must be between 30 and 40 hours per week and last between 6-16 weeks beginning at the earliest April 24th and not last beyond September 2nd. The deadline to apply is January 12, 2023.

<u>Supply Chain Stability and Adaptability Program</u> - The Ontario Ministry of Agricultre, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA) is investing \$10 million to address supply chain issues, reduce agri-food sector vulnerabilities, increase resilience and stregthen the food supply chain. More infomation will be provided at a <u>webinar</u> on January 10, 2023 at 12:00 p.m.

<u>FPSC Student Work Placement</u> - This funding provides up to \$7,000 in wage reimbursements to employers (per student and per academic term) and can be combined with other non-federal funding programs.

Whitepaper on How to Implement an Effective Traceability System

A whitepaper has been released to help organizations prepare for and manage product recalls. According to the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA), approximately 220 recall incidents occur each year with annual increases of over 10%. This whitepapaer will provide information on how to prepare for a recall situation, recent product recall trends and causes, a checklist to create a traceablity system and steps to manage product recalls. National Workforce Strategic Framework Released

The Canadian Agriculture Human Resource Council (CAHRC) along with the Canadian Federation of Agriculture and Food and Beverage Canada have released the National Workforce Strategic Framework that outlines the root causes of industry's labour shortages and skills gaps, identifies concrete actions to address these issues and sets meaningful goals and timelines to measure progress.
