ODC Scholarship Presentation - February 2, 2023

On February 2, 2023, ODC's Yves Leroux Advancing Excellence in Cheesemaking Scholarship will be presented for the second time at Conestoga College!

Ontario Dairy Council worked closely with two colleges in Ontario to develop a Professional Cheese Maker Training Program. The first full time program began in September 2021 at Conestoga College. The *Yves Leroux Advancing Excellence in Cheesemaking Award* is presented to a full-time student in this program. The presentation to this year's recipient will take place virtually on February 2 at 1:00 pm. and Yves Leroux will present the Award.

Member Fees

The ODC Board has approved a fee increase for the 2023-2024 fiscal period. The methodology for the increase is based on the 12-month rolling average of CPI as at December 31, 2022 (which is 6.3%, however, the Board capped the fee increase at 3.4%., The Board also agreed to increase the Non-Bovine flat fee from \$750 toe \$900. Last Chance to Renew Expiring PMG Certificates

Plant Milk Graders with certificates expiring on March 31, 2023 have a few last opportunities to renew. Refresher sessions are scheduled on the following dates:

- February 7, 2023 afternoon
- · February 9, 2023 afternoon
- March 21, 2023 morning or afternoon
- · March 22, 2023 morning or afternoon
- March 23, 2023 morning or afternoon

Non-Shopkeeper-Distributors (NSD) Must Be Licensed to Receive Milk

The Milk Act requires a Non-Shopkeeper-Distributor (NSD) to be licensed in order to receive fluid milk. It is the responsibility of the fluid milk supplier to ensure that the NSD receiving the milk holds a valid license as outlined in section 123 of Regulation 761 – Milk and Milk Products. The Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs, (OMAFRA) has indicated that not all NSDs are completing the renewal process. To help processors to comply with the regulation, OMAFRA maintains a list of on their website at Provincially licensed non-shopkeeper-distributors of fluid milk products ontario.ca

OMAFRA is in the process of communicating with plants that process fluid milk to provide more information. Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada in Consultation on New Funding Program

On January 25, 2023, ODC President participated in a meeting with Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada (AAFC) to consult on the development of the new funding program that will offer \$300 million to support innovation and investment into large-scale projects that add value to solids-not-fat. Staff have encouraged AAFC to implement the program as soon as possible.
