Plant Milk Grader (PMG) Refresher Training

ODC is the only authorized organization that can provide certification training for Plant Milk Graders (PMGs) in Ontario. The Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA) requires all PMG certificate holders to successfully complete a refresher course every five years in order to renew their certificate. If you or one of your employee's certification is up for renewal, you are urged to book one of the following refresher courses as soon as possible as sessions fill up quickly.

National School Food Policy

Allergen Management Guidelines for Food Manufacturers now available at no costs

Food Allergy Canada and Université Laval released a new publication, *Allergen Management Guidelines for food Manufacturers*. This publication is a consensus-based beverage manufacturing industry guide for allergen risk management and the use of precautionary allergen labelling. This <u>new guide</u> is available to food and beverage manufacturers across Canada at no charge.

Non-repayable contributions help to support investments in dairy processing facilities that improve productivity and/or efficiency through the purchase of new automated equipment and technology. Application intake period is open and will remain open until fund have been fully allocated.
