On July 16<sup>th</sup>, the United Kingdom became the first country to accede to the CPTPP since it came into force and, as a result, the agreement will represent 14.6% of global GDP and provide access to nearly 590 million consumers. Adding a third G7 economy with a GDP of \$3.6 trillion reinforces the influence of the Agreement, as well as its appeal to economies interested in joining.
